## UCem: University of Cantabria Entrepreneurship Awards

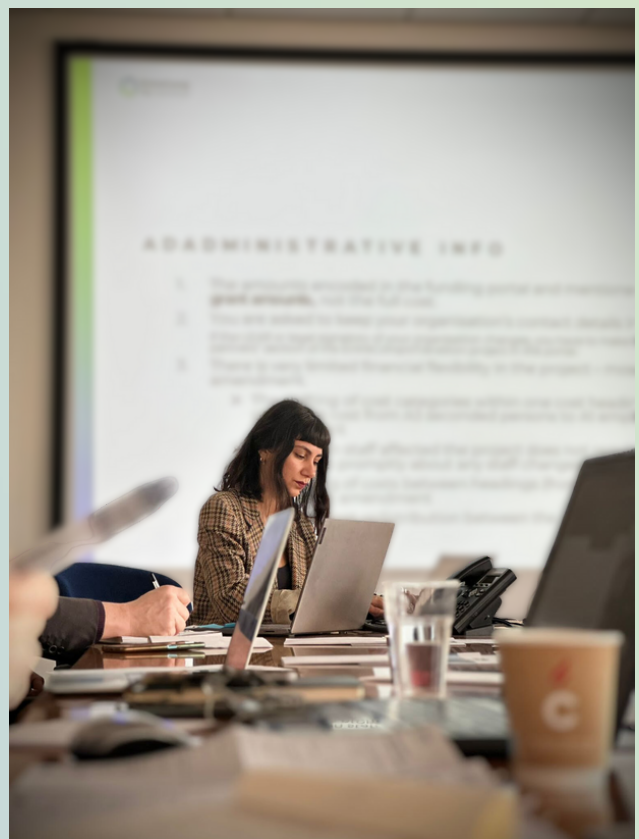
